Thanks,

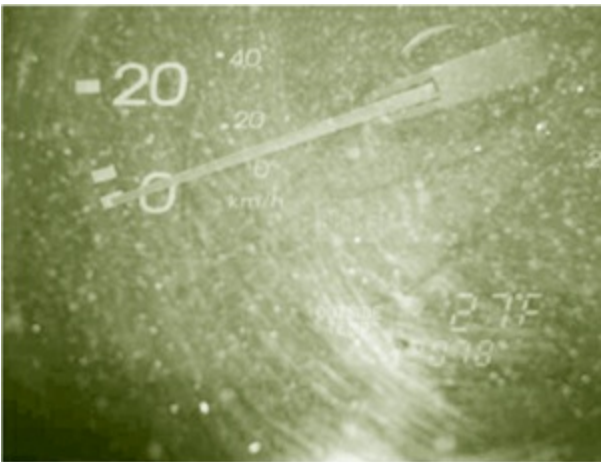

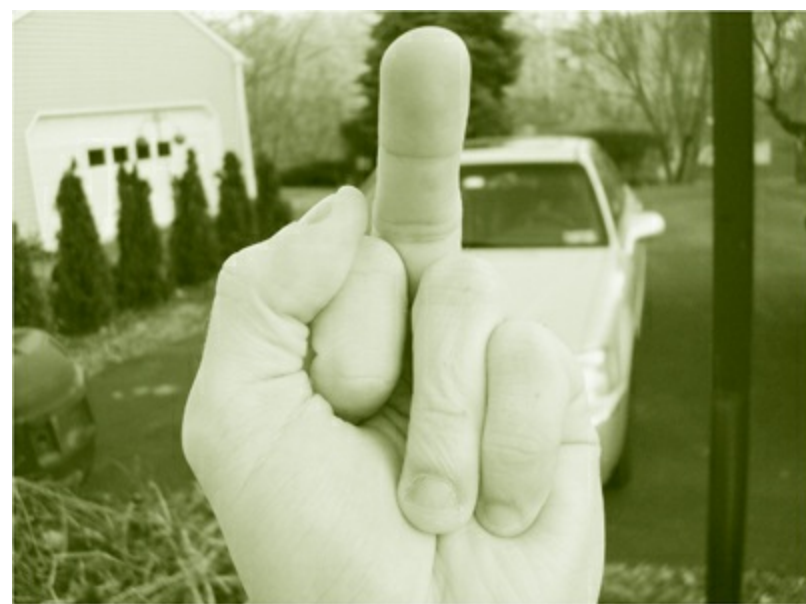
