Introduction

More afghans are crocheted each year than any other crochet project. Afghans are fun to make, cozy to use, and make wonderful gifts.

Afghan addicts will love the stitch patterns in this book. We've carefully chosen them so that they're not too open (who wants to catch a toe in an afghan?), and not too difficult or time-consuming.

This book is a reference tool you will use for years. You can crochet the stitch patterns in any weight of yarn and your own choice of colors!

Before You Begin

Unlike most crochet patterns, those in this book specify no gauge, no material requirements and no hook sizes.

That is because each stitch can be worked in your choice of yarn to vary the size and appearance of each stitch to fit your project.

When choosing the material and hook for your project, you may wish to do some experimenting

with a variety of materials until you achieve the appearance and texture that pleases you.

The stitch patterns photographed throughout this book were all made with worsted-weight yarn and a size I/9/5.5mm crochet hook.

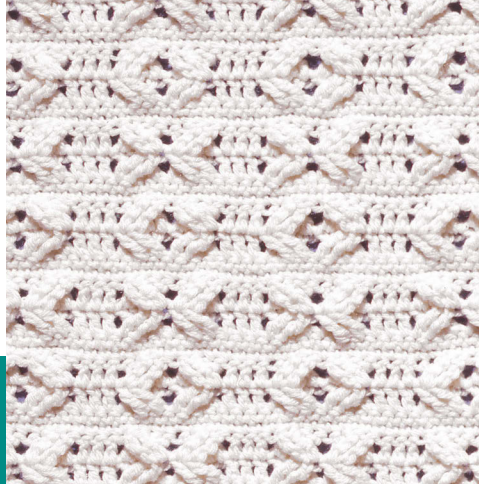
Multiples

A multiple is the number of chains required for each repeat of the stitch pattern; to this we may then add a specified number of chains to make the pattern end correctly.

If a pattern specifies a multiple of 6 sts + 2, for example, you need to make a foundation chain in multiples of 6 (12, 18, 24, etc.), then add a final 2 chains. The number of chains given after the + sign in a multiple is added only once.

Helpful Hint: When working a long foundation chain, add a few extra chains to ensure that the first row of the pattern will not run out of chains; then at the end of the first row, rip out any extra chains. ●

Chain-2 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Instructions

Foundation ch: Multiple of 11 sts + 4.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2 (see Pattern Notes), dc in each of next 2 sc, *sk next 2 sc, tr in each of next 2 sc, working behind tr just made, tr in each sk sc, sk next 2 sc, tr in each of next 2 sc, working in front of tr just made, tr in each sk sc, dc in next 3 sc, rep from * across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc, *sk next 2 tr, tr in each of next 2 tr, working behind tr just made, tr in each sk tr, sk next 2 tr, tr in each of next 2 tr, working in front of tr just made, tr in each sk tr, dc in each of next 3 dc, rep from * across, working last dc in last st, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

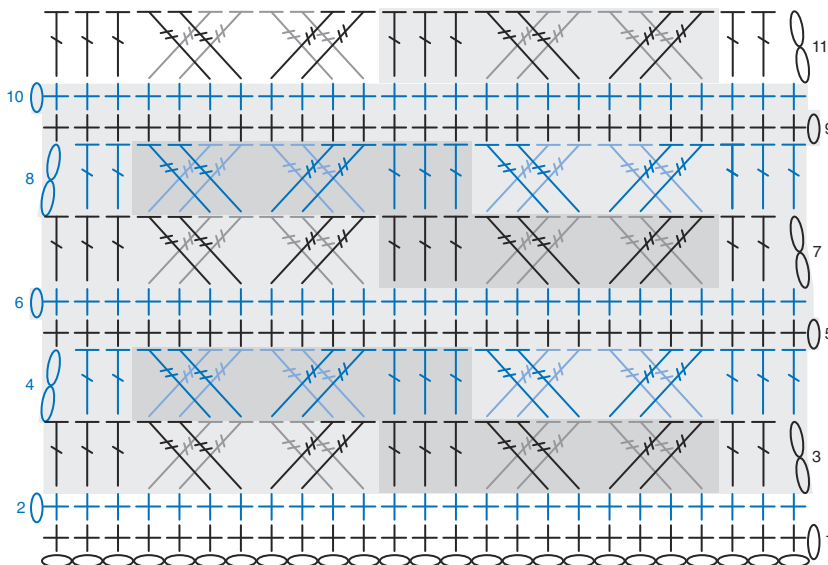
Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn.

Row 7: Ch 2, dc in each of next 2 sc, *sk next 2 sc, tr in each of next 2 sc, working in front of tr just made, tr in each sk sc, sk next 2 sc, tr in each of next 2 sc, working behind tr just made, tr in each sk sc, dc in each of next 3 sc, rep from * across, turn.

Row 8: Ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc, *sk next 2 tr, tr in each of next 2 tr, working in front of tr just made, tr in each sk tr, sk next 2 tr, tr in each of next 2 tr, working behind tr just made, tr in each sk tr, dc in each of next 3 dc, rep from * across, working last dc in last st, turn.

Rows 9 & 10: Rep rows 5 and 6.

Rep rows 3–10 to desired length, ending with row 6. At end of last row, fasten off. ●

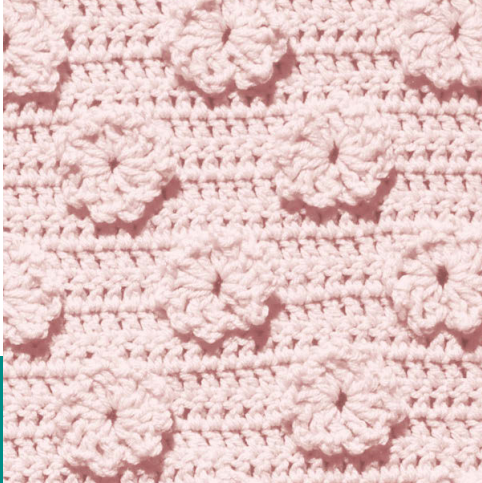
Reduced Sample of Stitch Diagram

Circle: Fpdc (see *Stitch Guide*) around post of next dc, ch 3, [fpdc, ch 3] 5 times around same post, turn piece upside down, [fpdc, ch 3] 5 times around post of previous dc on same row, fpdc around same post.

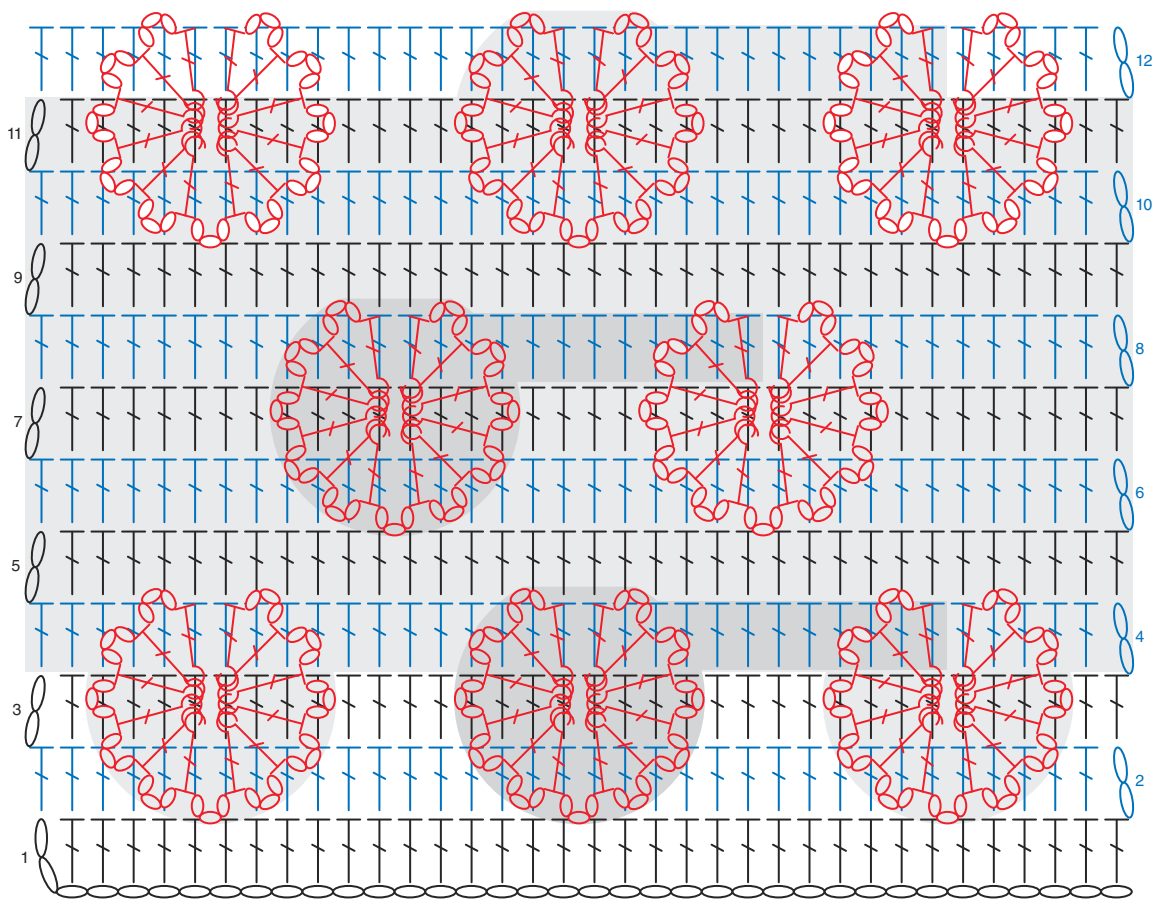
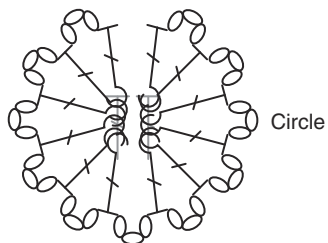
Foundation ch:

Multiple of 12 sts + 1.

Row 1 (WS): Dc in 3rd ch from hook (*beg 2 sk chs count as a dc*), dc in each rem ch across, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2 (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in each dc to beg 2 sk chs, dc in 2nd ch of beg 2 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, dc in each dc across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, dc in each of next 5 dc, **circle** (see *Special Stitch*), *working behind circle, dc in same dc as beg of circle made and in each of next 11 dc, circle, rep from * across to last 6 sts, dc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, dc in each of next 5 dc, sk next circle, *dc in each of next 12 dc, sk next circle, rep from * across to last 6 sts, dc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

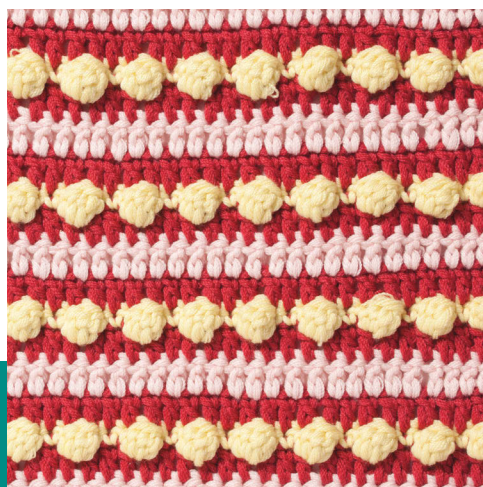
Rows 6 & 7: Rep row 3.

Row 8: Ch 2, dc in each of next 11 dc, circle, *dc behind same dc as beg of circle and in each of next 11 dc, circle, rep from * across to last 12 sts, dc in each of last 12 sts, turn.

Row 9: Ch 2, dc in each of next 11 dc, sk next circle, *dc in each of next 12 dc, sk next circle, rep from * across to last 12 sts, dc in last 12 sts, turn.

Rows 10 & 11: Rep row 3.

Rep rows 4–11 to desired length, ending with row 5. At end of last row, do not turn. Fasten off. ●

Yarn: A (light), B (dark) and C (yellow)

Pattern Notes

Refer to Stitch Diagram as needed.

Chain-2 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Special Stitch

Cluster (cl): Holding back last lp of each dc on hook, 4 dc in st indicated, yo and draw through all 5 lps on hook. Push cl to RS.

Instructions

Foundation ch: With A, multiple of 3 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Dc in 3rd ch from hook (*beg 2 sk chs count as a dc*), *dc in each rem ch across, change color to B by drawing lp through, cut A, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2 (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in each dc to beg 2 sk chs, dc in 2nd ch of beg 2 sk chs, change color to C by drawing lp through, cut B, turn.

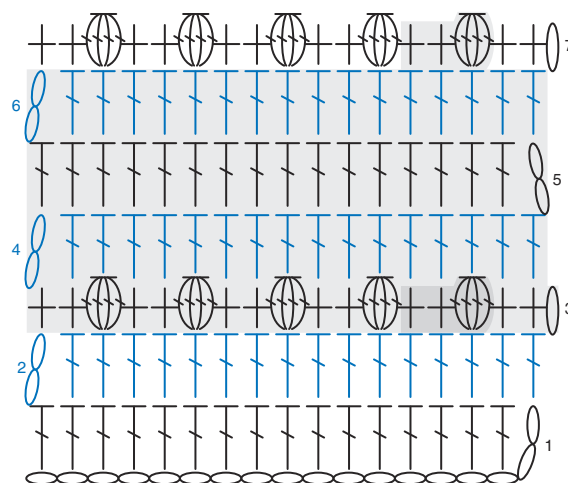

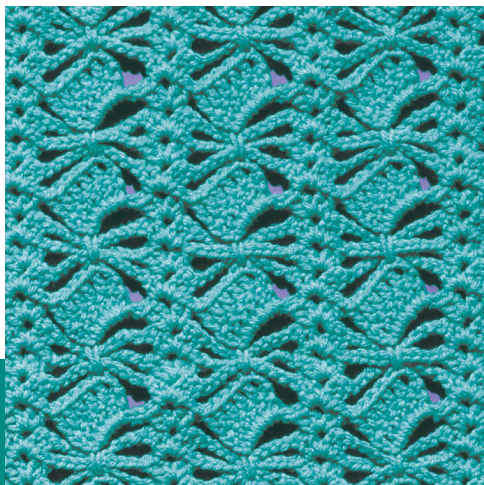
Row 4: Ch 2, dc in each sc and in each cl across, change color to A by drawing lp through, cut B, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, dc in each dc across, change color to B by drawing lp through, cut A, turn.

Row 6: Ch 2, dc in each dc across, change color to C by drawing lp through, cut B, turn.

Rep rows 3–6 to desired length, ending with row 5. At end of last row, do not turn. Fasten off. ●

Special Stitch

V-stitch (V-st): (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in indicated st.

Instructions

Foundation ch: Multiple of 10 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (*beg 2 sk chs count as a hdc*), hdc in each rem ch across, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2 (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in next hdc, sk next 2 hdc, ***V-st** (see *Special Stitch*) in next hdc, ch 5,

sk next 4 hdc, sc in next hdc, turn, ch 3, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp, turn, ch 3, dc in each of next 4 dc and in 3rd ch of beg ch-3 (*dc square made*), on working row, sk next 4 hdc, rep from * to last 5 sts, V-st in next hdc, sk next 2 hdc, dc in next hdc and in 2nd ch of beg 2 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *V-st in ch-2 sp of next V-st, ch 9, rep from * to last V-st, V-st in ch-2 sp of last V-st, sk next 2 dc of same V-st, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

Rows 4 & 5: Rep row 3.


Row 6: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *V-st in next V-st, ch 5, working over ch-9 sps of rows 3–5, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3 of dc square, turn, ch 3, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp, turn, ch 3, dc in each of next 4 dc and in 3rd ch of turning ch-3 (*dc square made*), rep from * across to last V-st, V-st in last V-st, sk next 2 dc of same V-st, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

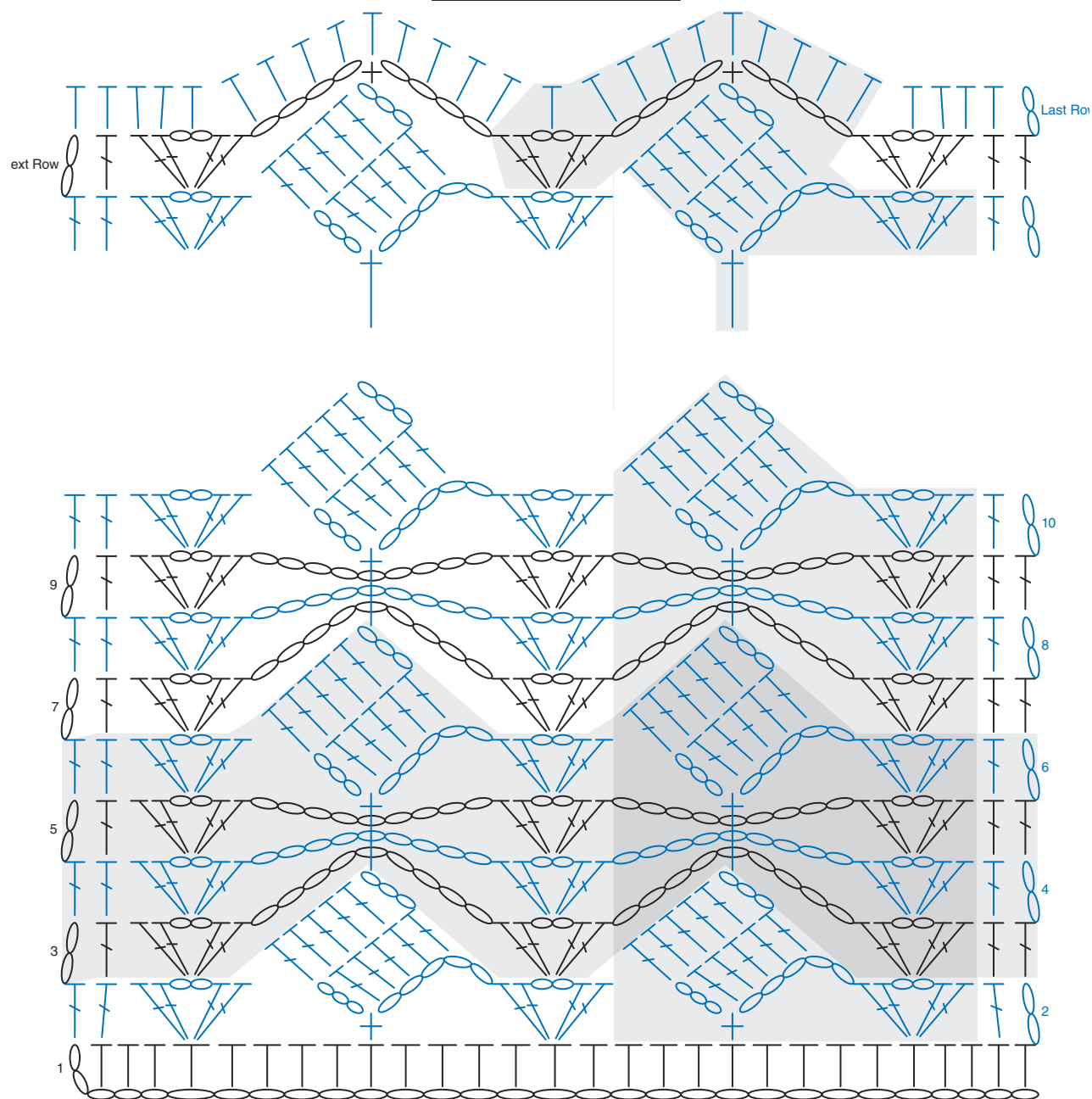
Rep rows 3–6 to desired length.

Next row: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *V-st in next V-st, ch 4, sk next 2 dc of same V-st and next 5 dc of dc square, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3 of dc square, ch 4, rep from * across to last V-st, V-st in last V-st, sk next 2 dc of same V-st, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

Last row: Ch 2, hdc in next dc, in each of next 2 dc of next V-st and in next ch-2 sp, *sk next 2 dc of same V-st, hdc in each of next 4 chs, in next sc, in each of next 4 chs, and in ch-2 sp of next V-st, rep from * across to last 2 dc of last V-st, hdc in last 2 dc of last V-st, dc in each of last 2 sts. Fasten off. ●

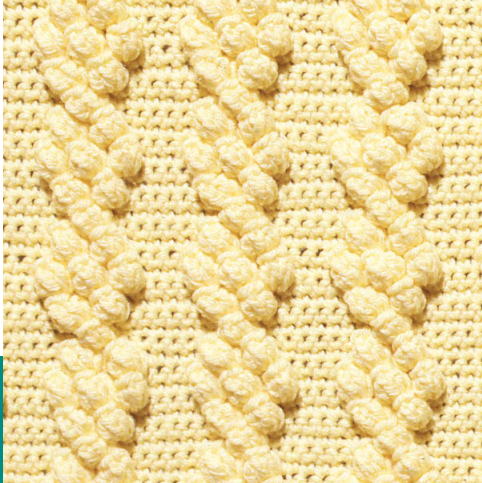

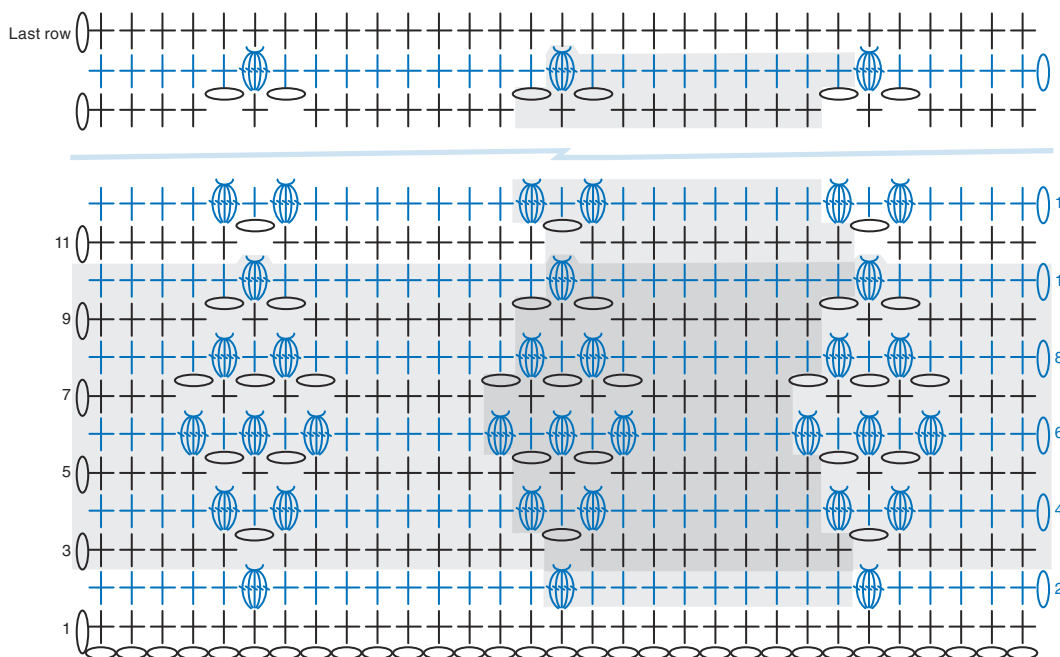

Popcorn (pc): 5 dc in st indicated, drop lp from hook, insert hook in first dc made, draw dropped lp through, pull tight.

Instructions

Foundation ch: Multiple of 10 sts + 2.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sc, ch 1, sk next pc, *sc in each of next 9 sc, ch 1, sk next pc, rep from * across to last 5 sc, sc in each of last 5 sc, turn.

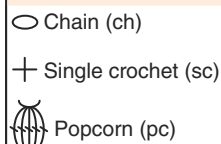
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sc, pc in next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp, pc in next sc, *sc in each of next 7 sc, pc in next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp, pc in next sc, rep from * across to last 4 sc, sc in each of last 4 sc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sc, ch 1, sk next pc, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk next pc, *sc in each of next 7 sc, ch 1, sk next pc, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk next pc, rep from * across to last 4 sc, sc in each of last 4 sc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, [pc in next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp] twice, pc in next sc, *sc in each of next 5 sc, [pc in next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp] twice, pc in next sc, rep from * across to last 3 sc, sc in each of last 3 sc, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, [ch 1, sk next pc, sc in next sc] twice, ch 1, sk next pc, *sc in each of next 5 sc, [ch 1, sk next pc, sc in next sc] twice, ch 1, sk next pc, rep from * across to last 3 sc, sc in each of last 3 sc, turn.

STITCH KEY



Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc and in next ch-1 sp, pc in next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp, pc in next sc, *sc in next ch-1 sp, in each of next 5 sc, and in next ch-1 sp, pc in next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp, pc in next sc, rep from * across to last ch-1 sp, sc in last ch-1 sp and in each of last 3 sc, turn.

Row 9: Rep row 5.

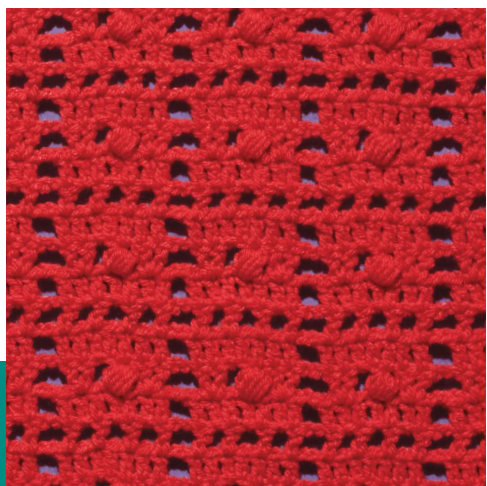
Row 10: Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sc and in next ch-1

sp, pc in next sc, *sc in next ch-1 sp, in each of next 7 sc, and in next ch-1 sp, pc in next sc, rep from * across to last ch-1 sp, sc in last ch-1 sp and in each of last 4 sc, turn.

Rep rows 3–10 to desired length.

Last row: Ch 1, sc in each sc and in each pc across. Fasten off. ●

Yarn: 1 color

Refer to Stitch Diagram as needed.

Chain-2 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Special Stitch

Puff stitch (puff st): (Yo, draw up lp in st indicated) 5 times, yo and draw through all 11 lps on hook. Push puff st to right side.

Instructions

Foundation ch: Multiple of 9 sts + 7.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 3rd ch from hook (*beg 2 sk chs count as a dc*), ch 2, *sk next 2 chs, dc in each of next 7 chs,

ch 2, rep from * across to last 4 chs, sk next 2 chs, dc in each of last 2 chs, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2 (*see Pattern Notes*), dc in next dc, ch 2, *sk next ch-2 sp and next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, **puff st** (*see Special Stitch*) in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next dc, rep from * across to last ch-2 sp, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 7 sts, rep from * across to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

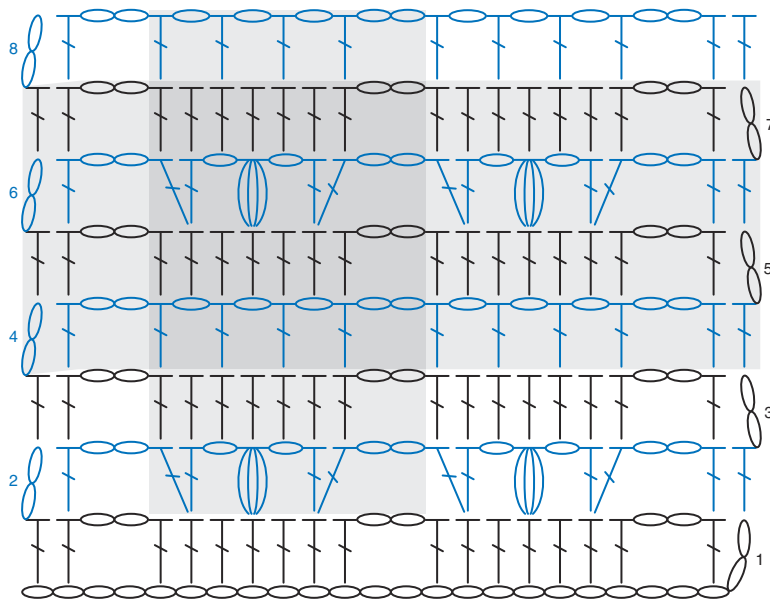
Row 4: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, [ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc] 3 times, rep from * across to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, [dc in next ch, dc in next dc] 3 times, rep from * across to last ch-2, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

Row 6: Ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, *sk next ch-2 sp and next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, puff st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next dc, rep from * across to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

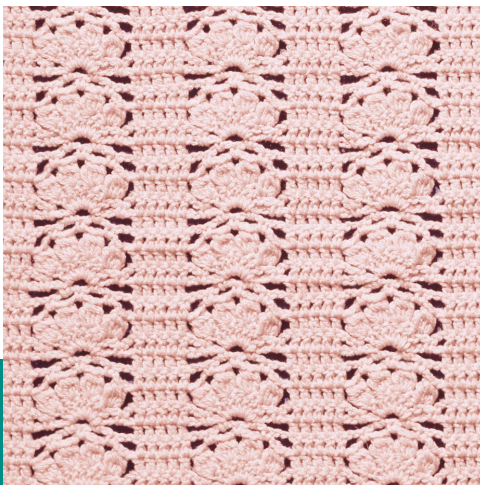
Row 7: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 7 sts, rep from * across to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

Rep rows 4–7 to desired length. At end of last row, do not turn. Fasten off. ●

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 3rd ch from hook (*beg 2 sk chs count as a dc*), dc in each of next 3 chs, *ch 4, sk next 4 chs, sc in next ch, ch 3, sk next ch, sc in next ch, ch 4, sk next 4 chs, dc in each of next 5 chs, rep from * across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2 (*see Pattern Notes*), dc in each of next 4 dc, *ch 2, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 1, 7 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, dc in each of next 5 dc, rep from * across, working last dc in 2nd ch of beg 2 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, dc in each of next 4 dc, *ch 1, sk next sc, **cl** (*see Special Stitch*) in next dc, [ch 3, sk next dc, cl in next dc] 3 times, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in each of next 5 dc, rep from * across, working last dc in last st, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, dc in each of next 4 dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next ch-3 sp, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp] twice, ch 2, sk next cl, dc in each of next 5 dc, rep from * across, working last dc in last st, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, dc in each of next 4 dc, *ch 4, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch

4, dc in each of next 5 dc, rep from * across, working last dc in last st, turn.

Rep rows 2–5 to desired length. At end of last row, do not turn. Fasten off. ●

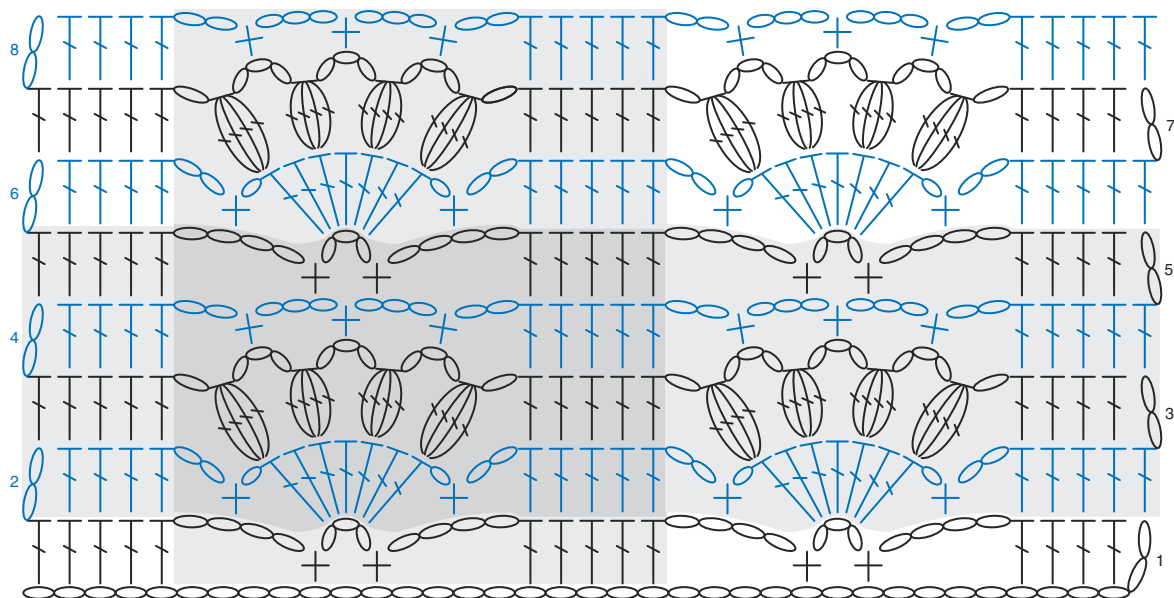

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, sc in first sc, *sk next 2 sc, **shell** (see *Special Stitch*) in next sc, sk next 2 sc, sc in next sc, rep from * across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2 (see *Pattern Notes*), 2 dc in first sc, sc in **back lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of 2nd tr of next shell, *5 dc in next sc, sc in back lp of 2nd tr of next shell, rep from * across to last sc, 3 dc in last sc, turn.



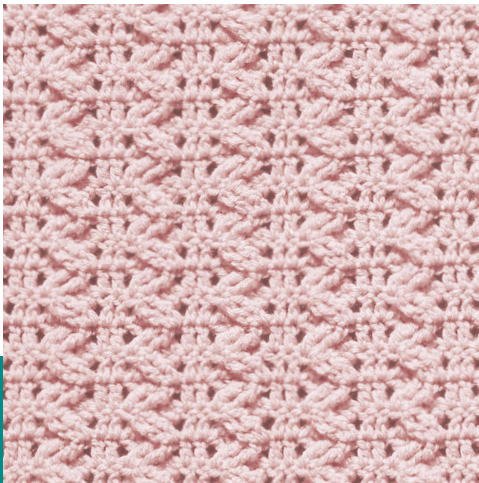

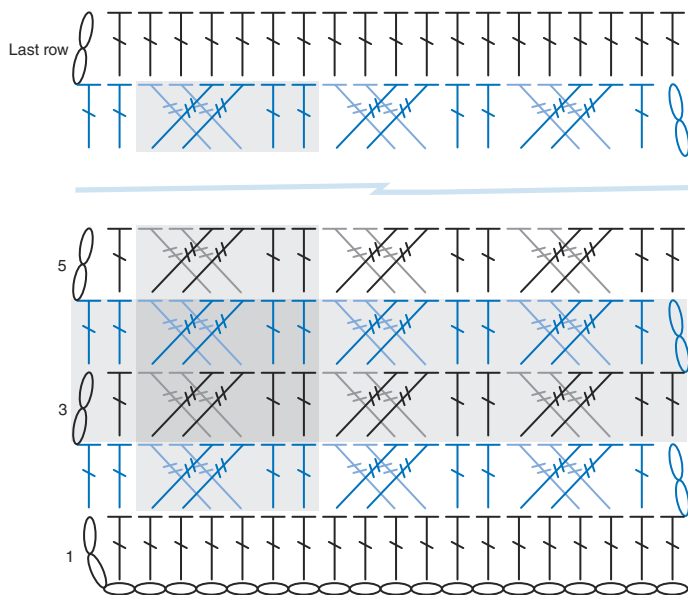

Row 3: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *sk next 2 tr, tr in each of next 2 tr, working in front of 2 tr just made, tr in each of 2 sk tr, dc in each of next 2 dc, rep from * across, working last dc in last st, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, dc in next dc, *sk next 2 tr, tr in each of next 2 tr, working behind 2 tr just made, tr in each of 2 sk tr, dc in each of next 2 dc, rep from * across, working last dc in last st, turn.

Rep rows 3 and 4 to desired length.

Last row: Ch 2, dc in each st across. Fasten off. ●

Special Stitch

Double treble crochet cluster (dtr cl): Holding back last lp of each dtr on hook, 3 dtr in indicated st, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook.

Instructions

Foundation ch: With A, multiple of 17 sts + 16.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 6 chs, 3 sc in next ch, sc in each of next 7 chs, *sk next 2 chs, sc in each of next 7 chs, 3 sc in next ch, sc in each of next 7 chs, rep from * across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sk first sc, working in **back lps** (see *Stitch Guide*), sc in each of next 7 sc, 3 sc in next sc (*point made*), *sc in each of next 7 sc, sk next 2 sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, 3 sc in next sc, rep from * to last 8 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, sk next sc, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Rep row 2.

Row 4: Rep row 2. At end of row, change color to next color in Color Sequence by drawing lp through, cut previous color, turn.

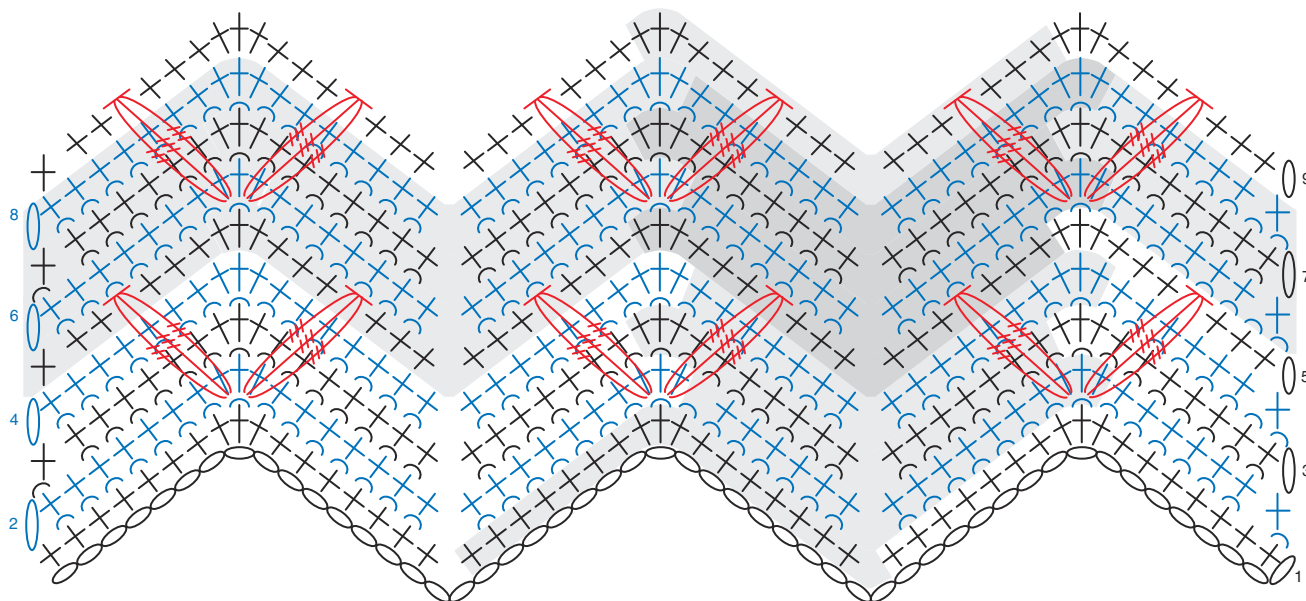
Row 5: Ch 1, sk first sc, working through both lps, sc in each of next 3 sc, **dtr cl** (see *Special Stitch*) in first unused lp of point in 3rd row below, on working row, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, dtr cl in 3rd unused lp of same point on 3rd row below, *on working row, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, sk next 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, dtr cl in first unused lp of next point on 3rd row below, on working row, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, dtr cl in 3rd unused lp of same point on 3rd row below, rep from * across to last 5 sc, on working row, sk next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, sk next sc, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sk first sc, working in back lp, sc in each of next 7 sts, 3 sc in next sc, *sc in each of next 7 sts, sk next 2 sc, sc in each of next 7 sts, 3 sc in next sc, rep from * across to last 8 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, sk next sc, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 7: Rep row 2.

Row 8: Rep row 2. At end of row, change color to next color in Color Sequence by drawing lp through, cut previous color, turn.

Working in Color Sequence, rep rows 5–8 to desired length. At end of last row, do not turn. Fasten off. ●

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sc, *ch 5, sk next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, rep from * across to last 5 sc, ch 5, sk next sc, sc in each of last 4 sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, *ch 3, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from * across, turn.

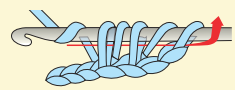
