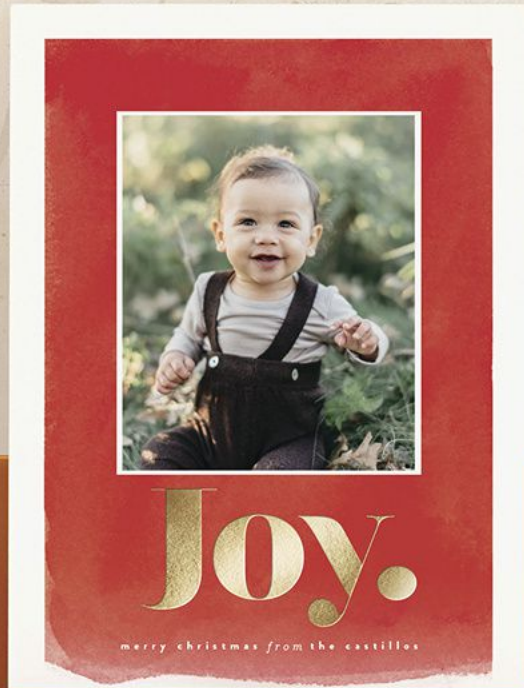

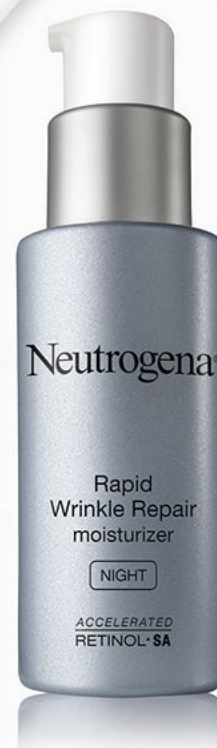

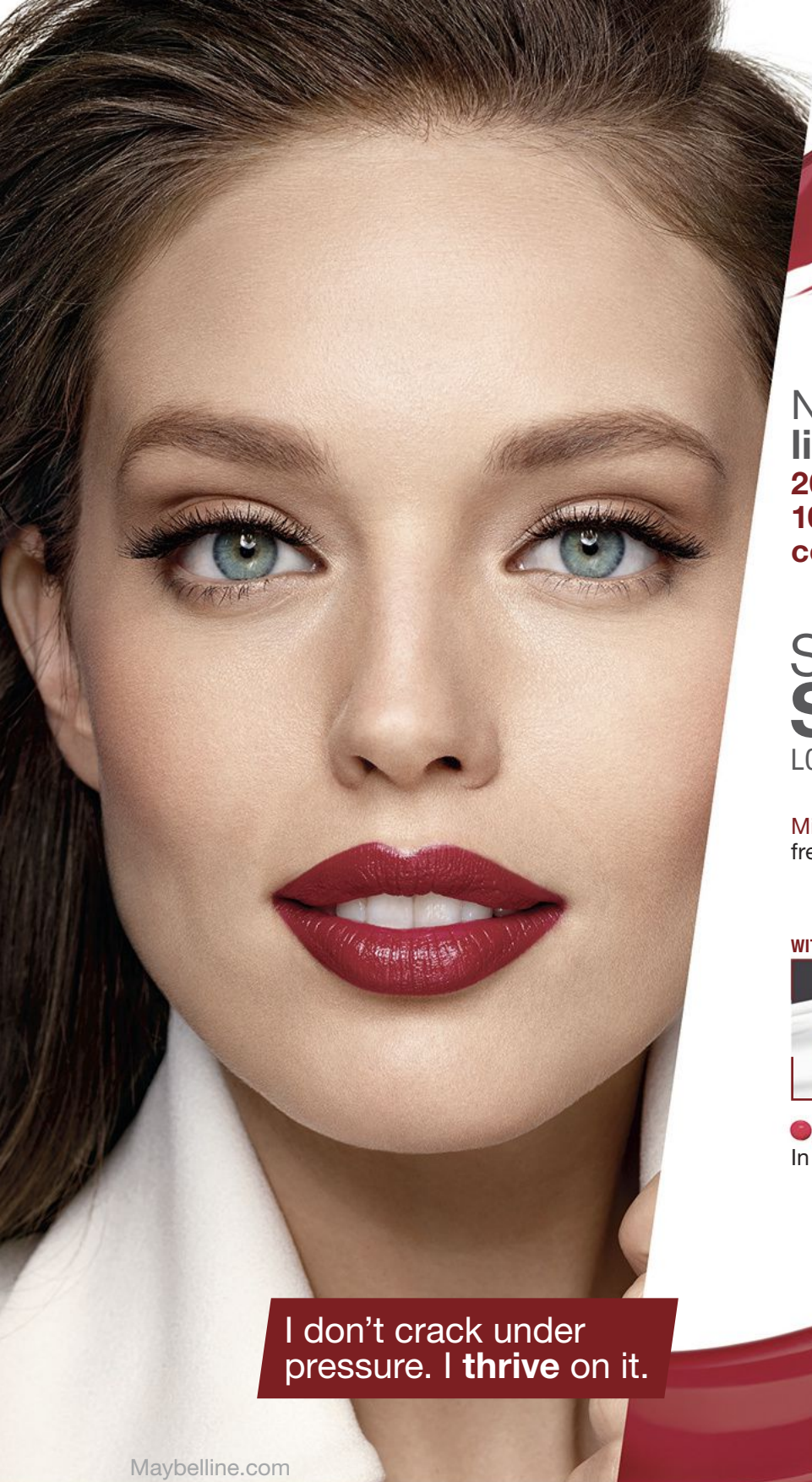

if your *thanksgiving* menu could talk...

It would serve a heaping helping of advice to make cooking the most anticipated meal of the year go off without a hitch.

**Defrosting
me can take a while.**

It takes 24 hours for every 4 to 5 pounds of turkey to defrost in the refrigerator. So that means a 20-pound turkey needs a minimum of four days to thaw. For best results, leave the turkey in its packaging (until the night before roasting), and place it breast-side-up on a tray on the bottom shelf of the fridge.

**My size
definitely matters.**

You'll need 1 to 1½ pounds of turkey per person to have enough for seconds and leftovers. Even if you don't have a big crowd, aim for a bird that's at least 12 pounds. Turkeys smaller than that have less meat on the bone.

**Double-check
my weight before
you set the timer.**

Roast your bird at 325°F for 12 minutes per pound. And get rid of the pop-up thermometer—those don't work properly. Invest in a digital food thermometer, and for the most accurate reading, jab it in where the drumstick meets the thigh.

**There's a secret
to my golden skin.**

The night before you roast your turkey, take it out of the plastic, and place it on a large roasting pan. Let it sit uncovered in the refrigerator overnight to dehydrate the skin. Right before you pop it in the oven, massage the skin with softened butter.

**After cooking,
I need a good, long rest.**

If you slice your bird right out of the oven, all the juices will stream out, leaving the meat dry. Give your turkey a 20-to-30-minute timeout before carving it, which will allow the juices to redistribute. Don't worry about it getting cold: A whole turkey can stay warm for up to an hour.

**Pick your
taters wisely.**

If you like fluffy mashed potatoes, choose starchy russets. For a creamy consistency, pick Yukon Golds. If you like a chunky style, opt for waxy Red Bliss. And stick to only one variety. Different kinds cook at different rates.

**Mash me
with a ricer.**

The more you work a potato, the more starch you release, which can lead to a gluey result. A ricer is the pros' tool of choice because it gently presses the potato into a soft fluff. A potato masher works if you like chunkier spuds.

On the super no-no list: blenders, handheld mixers, and food processors.

I hate hot water!

To make sure the inside and the outside cook evenly, cut potatoes into 1-inch chunks, put them in a pot, then add enough cold water to cover them by 1 inch and a few big pinches of salt. Bring to a boil, then lower the heat and simmer uncovered for about 20 minutes. When you can easily pierce them with a fork, they're done.

**I'm really not
high maintenance.**

You don't need a fat separator to make good gravy. Pour the drippings from your roasting pan into a liquid measuring cup. The fat will float to the top, where you can spoon it off. If a little fat sneaks in, no prob—that just means more flavor.

**I have a
secret formula.**

Gravy's golden rule: $\frac{1}{2}$ cup butter, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup flour, and 8 cups liquid (ideally a combination of drippings and broth) equals 8 cups of gravy. Here's what to do: In a saucepan, melt the butter over medium heat, then stir in the flour until it looks like wet sand and smells a little nutty. Slowly whisk in the drippings and broth. Season with salt and pepper.

**I should be
the last thing you make.**

Gravy *can* be prepared ahead of time, but that would mean missing out on the best thing about it: the flavor from the turkey drippings. Plan for gravy to be very last on your to-do list. Your turkey needs to rest for 20 to 30 minutes before it can be carved anyway, so use that window to make the gravy.

Cranberries ripen to their peak color and flavor between mid-September and mid-November, so the bags of berries you see in grocery stores right now are fresh. Before you buy, shake the bag and take a good look: Berries should be firm and shiny.

**Don't
oversweeten me!**

If the sauce is too sweet, it won't go well with your savory Thanksgiving dishes. For every 12-ounce bag of fresh cranberries, add 2 tablespoons of water and 1 cup of sugar. Cook on low heat until the cranberries pop and give off their liquid, about 10 to 20 minutes.

**It's not easy
staying green.**

To avoid sad khaki-color beans, drop them in salted boiling water, and cook until they're bright green and tender, 2 to 3 minutes. Transfer to a bowl of ice water for a few seconds to stop their cooking, then drain and pat dry with a paper towel.

**You can
buy me in advance.**

Up to five days! Look for fresh beans that are firm and blemish-free. Don't wash them before putting them in the fridge, and if they were under a mister at the store, dry them, put them in a zip-top bag, and store them in the crisper. Also, don't trim in advance. The cut side will dry out.

**There's nothing
stringy about me.**

Thanks to modern science, the string has been bred out of modern green beans, meaning you don't need to string them before cooking. To prep, cut off the woody stem, but you can leave on the tapered end—it's tender and fine to eat.

**It's smart to
make me first.**

Thanks to cranberries' high acidity and natural antimicrobial compounds, homemade cranberry sauce will keep well in a refrigerated airtight container for at least a week—and the flavors will deepen as the sauce sits. Give it a quick stir before serving.

**I'm nutritious.
Really!**

Pie isn't exactly diet food, but pumpkin puree is a great source of fiber, iron, potassium, and vitamin A. If you insist on calorie-counting on Thanksgiving Day, an average piece of pumpkin pie has about 325 calories, while a slice of pecan pie has around 500.

**I'm not
ashamed of my canned
ingredients.**

Don't bother to roast and puree a pumpkin. It takes forever and can lead to filling that's stringy, watery, and not sweet enough. Canned pure pumpkin has good flavor and a consistent texture. Don't use pumpkin pie filling, which has sugar and spices already added. It's better to tweak the flavor yourself.

**I can be
semi-homemade.**

A store-bought crust is totally acceptable. Just choose an all-butter one. Palm oil kinds can taste greasy and lack that distinctively rich crust flavor. If you're using a frozen crust, defrost it, spoon in the filling, and pop it straight into the oven. When working with a rolled refrigerated crust, let it soften slightly on the counter so it won't crack when you put it in your pie plate.

**I'm not
perfect when I
come out of the oven.**

Pumpkin pie takes about an hour to bake at 350°F. Pull it out of the oven when it's still slightly jiggly in the center, even if it seems a little underdone. It will continue to firm up while it cools.

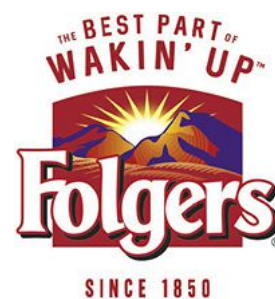
**Play around
with my measurements.**

Pumpkin pie recipes are pretty standard—pumpkin, sugar, eggs, and some kind of dairy—but there's no rule that says you can't get creative with the spices. General amounts for a 9-inch pie are ½ teaspoon each of cinnamon, nutmeg, ground ginger, and allspice, and ¼ teaspoon of ground cloves. Omit one, beef up another, or try adding 2 tablespoons of bourbon to the filling.

how bad is it...

Straight answers to scratch-your-head questions.



...to cook savory and sweet dishes in the oven at the same time?

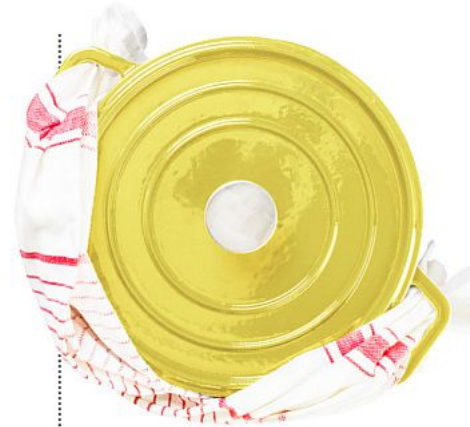
When it comes to getting every pan in formation on a major holiday, dinner and dessert belong on separate teams. Cooking savory and sweet foods at the same time is bound to affect their taste, especially that of desserts, according to Neale Holaday, head pastry chef at Marlow & Sons in Brooklyn, NY. "The flavors of pastry dough, fruits, and chocolate are delicate and easily susceptible to taking on strong flavors around them, like those from onions, garlic, and meat," she says. Instead of cooking everything in one day, Holaday suggests doing your baking the day before. "Typically pies, tarts, cookies, and cakes should set before they're served, so it's actually best to make them ahead anyway," she says. If you're crunched for time and must make an exception, bake the dessert when you have a mild veggie dish in the oven, just not with the meat.

pretty bad!

...to burn a scented candle during dinner?

Fragrance coming from anything other than the feast on the table is an unwanted dinner guest. That's because our ability to enjoy a meal involves both taste and smell, says Pamela Dalton, Ph.D., an olfactory scientist at the Monell Chemical Senses Center. In fact, studies have found that our sense of smell is responsible for at least 75% of flavor perception. Dalton suggests testing this with a jelly bean: "If you pinch your nose and chew it, you'll taste the sweetness but not necessarily the flavor of the jelly bean, like peach or licorice. Let go of your nose and you'll get the flavor." Burning a scented candle while people are eating will interfere with their ability to distinguish between the flavor of the food and the candle's aroma—and you don't want guests tasting pine trees with their turkey.

really bad!



...to use a dish towel to carry a hot pot?

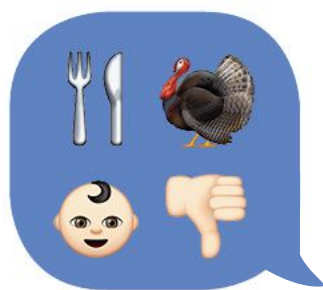
Grabbing a dish towel may be a natural reaction, especially when it's within arm's reach and the pot holders are tucked away in a drawer. But don't do it even in a pinch, says family wellness expert Alison Jacobson, a.k.a. The Safety Mom. Pot holders and oven mitts are designed with protective insulation to withstand heat. Cotton and linen dish towels offer no protection and are extra dangerous when damp. "The water on the towel will heat to the temperature of the hot dish and can scald you," says Jacobson. A towel is also longer, making it a fire hazard near an open flame, and it doesn't have any gripping material, which means you could have trouble getting a handle on a heavy skillet.

super bad!

...to lie down right after a big meal?

Kicking back post-pumpkin pie isn't the best idea, according to registered dietitian Stephanie Clairmont, founder of the web-based Clairmont Digestive Clinic. Because lack of movement slows the metabolic process, napping while your body converts calories into energy means that more calories may be stored as fat than if you were doing something active. Thanksgiving dinner is a double whammy: Not only is it highly caloric, but it's also a meal that people tend to overeat, and carbs and tryptophan-filled turkey make you tired in the first place. Those prone to heartburn should definitely avoid plopping down because high-fat meals trigger acid reflux, and lying flat exacerbates the symptoms. So do your physique a favor and help with the dishes or, better yet, take a walk around the block.

really bad!



...to put teens at the kids' table?

It depends on the teen...and the kids. While some teens would rather talk to adults, others might want to sit with their siblings, cousins, and friends. In general, if you want to put a child age 12 or older at a kids' table, make him or her part of the decision, says parenting educator Rosalind Wiseman, author of *Queen Bees and Wannabes*. "Teens want to be recognized for being at least a little grown-up, so acknowledge that it's awkward and that you appreciate them going along with it," she says. Wiseman also suggests nixing the kids' table entirely so kids learn how to have conversations with adults—an important social skill. That also allows you to keep an eye on their cell phone use if you'd prefer they didn't Snapchat at the table.

sorta bad!

...to give your dog turkey scraps?

Just because he can't join you at the table doesn't mean your pup has to miss out on Thanksgiving. A healthy dog diet is about moderation, says Brian Collins, D.V.M., a lecturer at Cornell University College of Veterinary Medicine in Ithaca, NY. So unless your dog is on a restrictive diet, it's fine to give him a piece of lean turkey meat—but skip the bones and skin. And don't overdo it. As Dr. Collins points out, it's never a good idea to give your pet a large helping of a food he's not used to. Turkey, bits of a dinner roll, and vegetables are generally fine unless they're cooked with onions, which can be harmful to dogs. High-fat foods, on the other hand, can upset a pooch's stomach, so butter, gravy, mashed potatoes made with cream, and desserts are off-limits.

not bad at all!



...to use the shared hand towel in a guest bathroom?

"It may seem gross, but it's not generally a health risk," says infectious disease scientist Jason Tetro, author of *The Germ Files*. Here's the deal: While it's true that few people wash their hands properly after using the toilet—that means about 40 seconds with soap and water—hand towels usually have time to dry out between uses, cutting off bacteria growth. Even during the busy holiday season, when the bathroom is used frequently and towels may not dry completely, people with a healthy immune system aren't likely to catch a bug from a damp towel. (You have a greater chance of getting sick from someone double-dipping at cocktail hour, Tetro says.) Still, if the idea yucks you out, wash your hands thoroughly, then dry them with toilet paper if there are no disposable towels available.

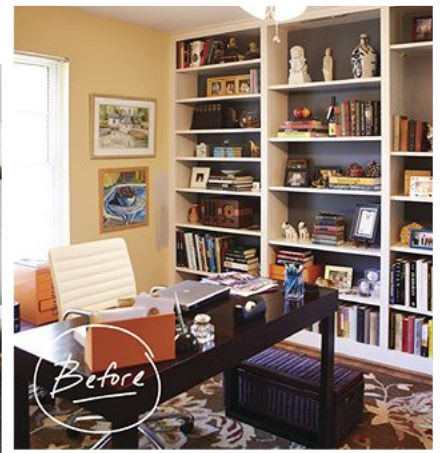

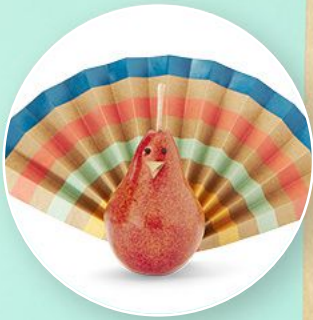

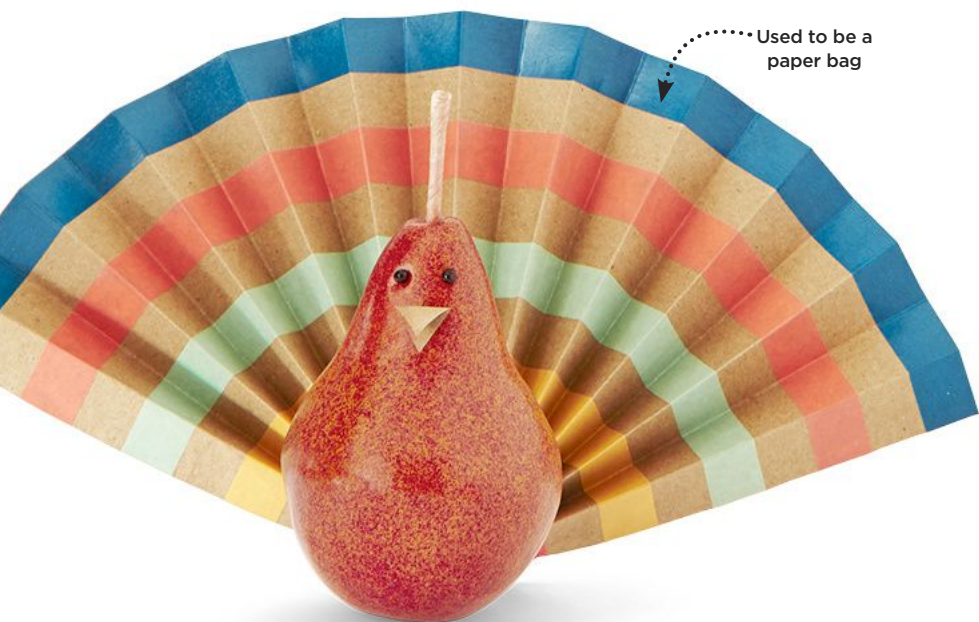

4. Stick two straight pins into the pear for eyes. Cut a small diamond out of the paper bag, and fold it in half for the beak. Attach the beak to the pear with double-sided tape.

1. Cut a rectangle out of a brown paper bag that is the height of a votive candleholder and wide enough to wrap around it plus half an inch.
2. Use a foam pouncer to coat a wood grain stamp with white crafts paint. Lay the paper flat and stamp it so the wood grain pattern runs vertically. Let dry.
3. Wrap the paper around the candleholder, and secure it with double-sided tape where the ends overlap.

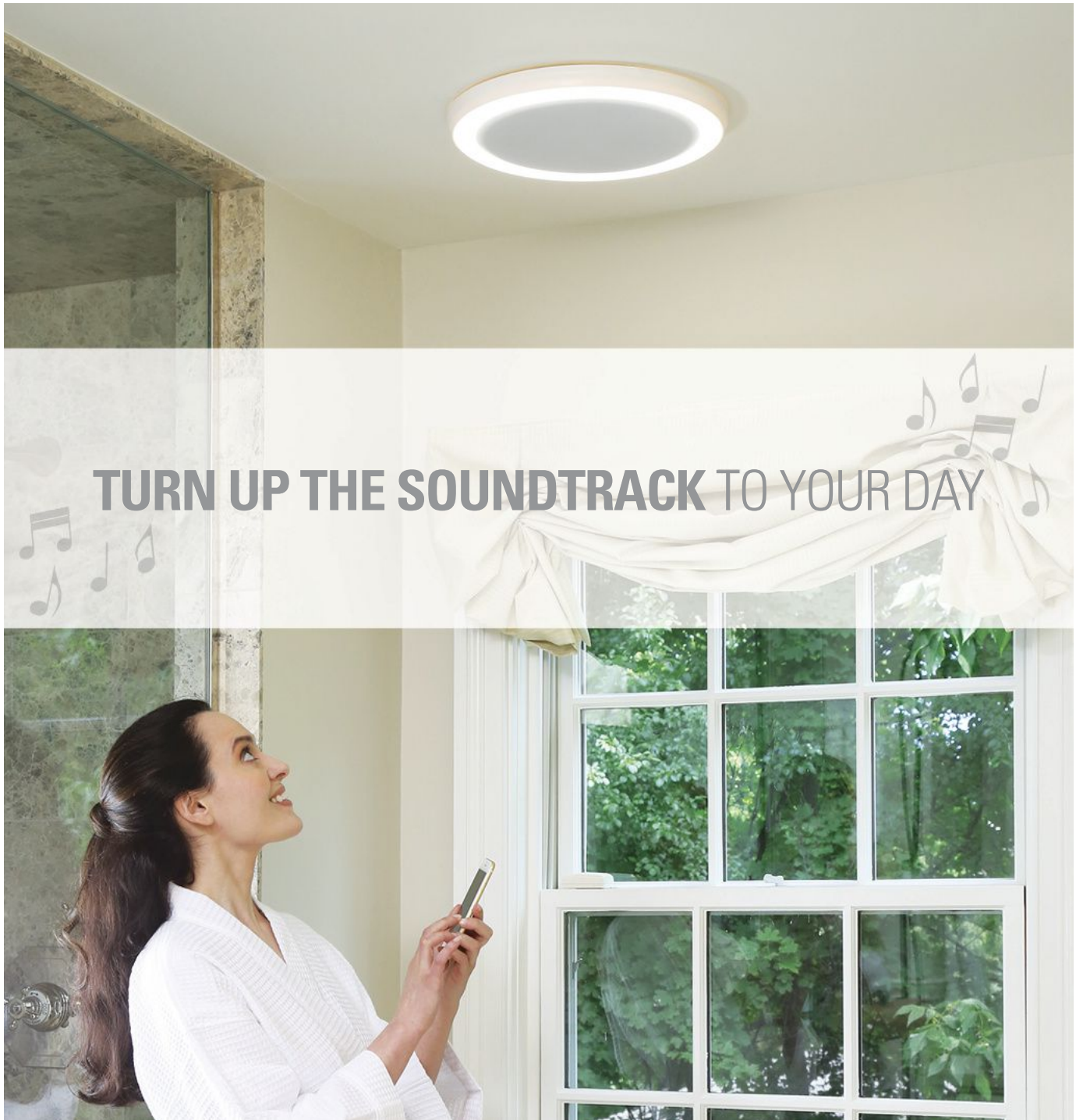

3. Trace the feather templates onto the pieces of paper, and cut them out.

5. Glue the feathers to a cord or twine, as shown. Let dry.

paper bag faceted vases

1. Go to hgvtv.com/paper-vase to download the vase templates. We designed them to fit around 7½-inch-tall and 10-inch-tall cylindrical vases. Print the templates and cut them out.
2. For each vase, cut out a piece of a brown paper bag that is a little larger than the template. Lay it flat with the template on top. Score the lines on the template using a ruler and a bone folder to make impressions on the paper. Using a pencil, trace around the edges of the template onto the paper, and cut it out.
3. Paint random triangles inside the scored lines on the paper with crafts paint. Brush

white glue onto a few triangles, and sprinkle with gold glitter. Let dry.

4. To create the faceted look, fold all the diagonal lines into mountain folds (see Fig. A). Then fold the horizontal lines into valley folds (see Fig. B).

5. Wrap the paper around the vase, and secure it with double-sided tape where the ends overlap.

Shelby and Sam Grayeli had just completed renovations on their home in West Los Angeles, CA, when Shelby saw a listing for a 1935 Spanish ranch house five minutes away. Unable to resist its charm, she convinced her husband to check it out. His reaction was less than enthusiastic. “He thought it was terrible—it hadn’t been touched since the ‘80s—and that I was insane for falling for it,” says Shelby. But she was so smitten by the ample size (3,600 square feet) and the location (near the campus of UCLA, Sam’s beloved alma mater) that she talked Sam into making an offer. Less than 48 hours later, it was accepted, and so began a whirlwind few months of selling their old home and renovating the new one more extensively than planned after they discovered it was (brace yourself) infested with rats. The reno included an overhaul of the kitchen and bathrooms, and major construction work to create a master bedroom. When it was done, Shelby, a collector of vintage furniture, rugs, and light fixtures, worked with designer Irene Lovett to pull together a look that mingles Shelby’s old finds with new pieces so it feels like they’ve been together forever.

“When I get tired of seeing something in the same place, I rearrange,” says Shelby. This cane-back settee, which she bought at the Rose Bowl Flea Market and reupholstered in coral-and-pink fabric from Raoul Textiles, used to live at the foot of daughter Alexis' bed. The old rug is an eBay find, and the mirror was picked up years ago during Shelby's self-described “obsession” with mother-of-pearl inlay.

“Our house sits on a pretty busy corner, so I like that it feels like a retreat with all the greenery surrounding it,” says Shelby. The Grayelis kept the tile roof that was added in the '80s, but they refinished the exterior with a smooth style of stucco often used on historic buildings in Santa Barbara.

The newly added second story gave the living room tons of vertical space. The walls and vaulted ceiling are painted the same pale green-gray (Sparkling Sage by Valspar). To keep the 19-foot-tall expanse from looking bare, Brian installed textured white clay tiles on the fireplace wall. The two matching sofas, upholstered in gray polyester, and the dramatic live-edge coffee table are from overstock.com. "The table looks more like a sculpture than a piece of furniture," says Brian. The flooring throughout the house is white oak stained Aged Pewter by Bona.

this year *HGTV Urban Oasis* headed (mid)west to the bustling college town of Ann Arbor, MI. That's where designer Brian Patrick Flynn, with the help of Studio Z Architecture, turned a dilapidated 1925 cottage into an adorable, modern bungalow. After six months of work, the former one-story house now boasts two floors; nearly twice the space (approximately 1,500 square feet, up from a mere 840); and a big,

welcoming front porch complete with a row of rocking chairs. Brian filled the house with mid-century-style furniture in neutral colors and included nods to its Michigan roots, like an original painting of a 1950s station wagon to honor the nearby Motor City. "We wanted the interiors to feel fresh," Brian says. "But on the outside, it still looks like it's been part of the neighborhood for a hundred years."



dining room

To make the rough-hewn pedestal table look more sleek and less rustic, Brian paired it with modern gray upholstered chairs. "They remind me of tailored menswear jackets," he says. The bronze-finish chandelier mimics the table's shape, and the rug is made from triangles cut from cowhide. Brian wanted a seamless transition from the living room to this room—it's all one open floor plan—so he painted it the same soothing color and hung matching mossy gray linen curtains.



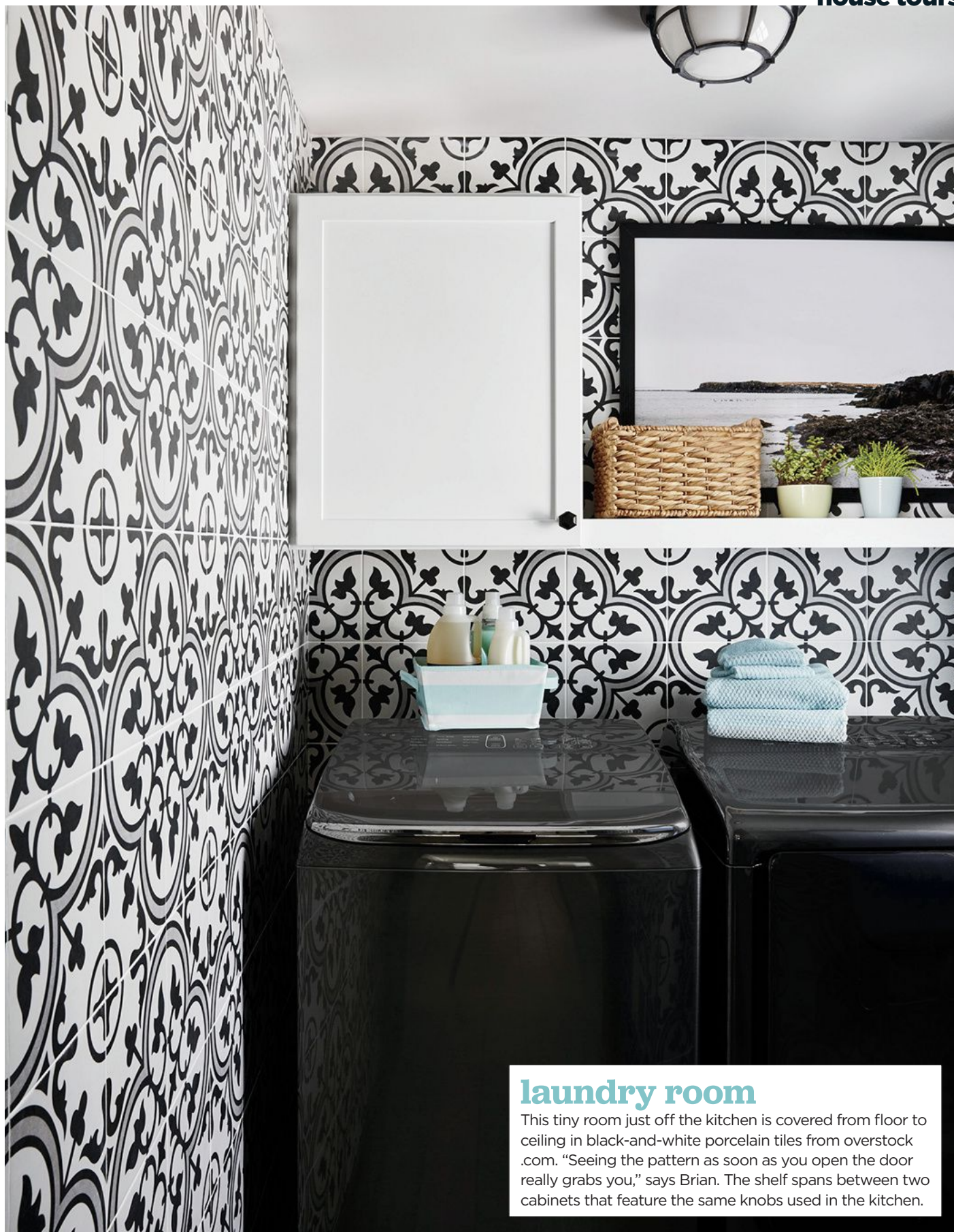
